Methods:

- •Three 100+ Acre Fields
- •Sow Cover Crops and then Graze
- •Measure Growth of Animals While on Trial
- Use a Bale of Hay To
 Differentiate Treatments
- SowOats/Turnipsand Rye/CrimsonClover AeriallyBroadcast

Wheat/Barley



Results

- •Calves grazing cover crops gained weight throughout the fall and winter
- Oat/Turnip ADG 2.68 lbs/day
- Rye/Crimson Clover ADG
- 1.58 lbs/day
- Wheat/Barley ADG
- 2.34 lbs/day

Lessons Learned

- •Early Sowing = Early Grazing
- Avoid Water Haul
- Herbicide Carryover in dry years may be a problem
